CA 125 (cancer antigen 125) is a tumour marker or biomarker that may be elevated in the blood of some people with specific types of cancers. CA 125 is a mucinous glycoprotein and the product of the MUC16 gene. It is best known as a marker for ovarian cancer, but it may also be elevated in other malignant cancers.
